

Credential Information, Credential Cards and Voting

Savannah Diocesan Council of Catholic Women Bylaws Article XIV

Section 1. Each parish affiliate and each inter-parochial society or local branch of a national organization in good standing with the Savannah Diocesan Council of Catholic Women, shall be entitled to three (3) voting delegates or alternates at the Annual Convention.

Each parish, upon payment of dues to your diocesan council, has three votes and will receive three credential cards.

Section 2. The voting membership of the Annual Convention shall consist of the affiliate delegates or their alternates and the members of the Board of Directors of the organization.

If you are appointed as a voting delegate, and are unable to attend the convention, your alternate will vote in your place at the convention. The women currently serving on the Savannah Diocesan Council of Catholic Women Board of Directors are voting delegates and will receive their credential cards in a separate mailing.

Section 3. No delegate shall be allowed to represent more than one (1) organization. Each delegate shall have one (1) vote at the Annual Convention.

Votes may not be transferred from one parish to another. A Diocesan Board member may not use a parish affiliate vote.

Section 4. The President of each affiliated organization shall certify the names of the delegates and alternates of the organization to the Credential Committee of the organization.

The President of your parish affiliate must approve or appoint all voting delegates or alternates and must sign the Credentials Cards. One half of the completed card must be mailed to the Credential Committee Chairman.

Section 5. The Credential Committee shall consist of four (4) members appointed by the (SDCCW) President. Each member shall be from a different Deanery.
